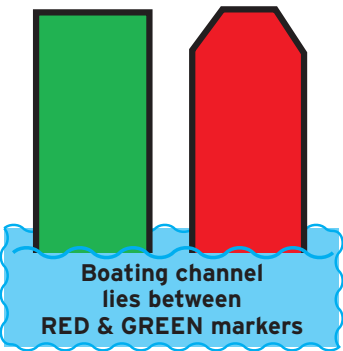

- All buoys and swim rafts require a permit from the Cass County Sheriff.
- Respect your neighbors on roadways surrounding Ten Mile Lake.
- Observe speed limits and slow down for pedestrians and cyclists.

- PLEASE RESPECT PRIVATE PROPERTY
  - REPORT ANY BOATING VIOLATIONS BY BOAT NUMBER
  - AND CALL THE CASS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE - 218-547-1424
- All watercraft will yield right-of-way to an authorized watercraft displaying **RED** or **BLUE** flashing lights.

## SUMMARY OF THE MINNESOTA BOATING LAWS

*All children under 10 years old must wear  
a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) on any watercraft that is underway*

ALL MOTORBOATS	WATERCRAFT LAWS	WATERCRAFT GENERAL INFORMATION/LAWS
Less than 12 years old	1 - 25 hp or less - no restriction. 2 - More than 25 hp through 75 hp - must have someone at least 21 on board in reach of controls. 3 - Over 75 hp - cannot operate, even with an adult on board.	Please pay close attention to Watercraft Licensing - basically all watercraft over 9 feet in length must be registered. Check the regulations, or call the Sheriff Water Safety Division for this or any other water questions.
12-17 years old	1 - 25 hp or less - no restrictions 2 - Over 25 hp - must either have a watercraft operator's permit, or someone at least 21 on board in reach of controls.	Navigation lights must be on from sunset to sunrise.  <b>Always wear your life jacket (PFD)</b> <b>One (PFD) per occupant, plus a throwable device are required per watercraft.</b>
PERSONAL WATERCRAFT (Jet Skies, etc., regardless of horsepower)	PERSONAL WATERCRAFT LAWS	
Less than 13 years old	1 - Cannot operate, even with an adult on board.	<b>YOU MUST...</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Wear a USCG approved life jacket</li><li>• Travel at slow no-wake speed within 150 feet of: non-motorized boats, shore (unless launching, or landing skiers directly to open water), dock, swim raft, or any moored or anchored boat.</li><li>• Operate only from 9:30 am to 1 hour before sunset.</li><li>• Use the cutoff lanyard properly.</li></ul>
13 years old	<b>Must either have:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1 - Someone at least 21 on board, or</li><li>2 - A watercraft operator's permit, and be in unaided visual contact by someone at least 21</li></ul>	<b>YOU MAY NOT...</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Chase or harass wildlife.</li><li>• Jump the wake of another boat within 150 feet of the other boat.</li><li>• Operate a personal watercraft in a manner that endangers life, limb, or property.</li><li>• Operate at full speed within 150 feet of shoreline, dock, raft.</li></ul>
14-17 years old	<b>Must have:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>1 - A watercraft operator's permit, or</li><li>2 - Have someone at least 21 on board.</li></ul> (MN Driver License does not count - you must have a Watercraft Operators Permit).
